LETTER DATED 30 APRIL 1993 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I. OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF YUGOSLAVIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I am writing to you in connection with the letters of Mr. Muhamed Sacirbey, dated 17 and 27 April 1993 (S/25624 and S/25670), addressed to you.

The above-mentioned letters belong to a series of concoctions which inundate the United Nations on a daily basis with a view to presenting deliberately distorted facts and continuing a slander propaganda campaign against the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia. The allegations of "aggression and participation" of the armed forces of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia on the territory of Bosnia and Herzegovina are not only falsehoods but a part of a broader scenario aimed at provoking foreign military intervention.

We cannot but categorically reject such attempts since they cannot lead to peace but can only exacerbate the situation.

I should be grateful if you would have the present letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
