ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS TO THE UNITED NATIONS

<u>Letter dated 26 May 1993 from the President of the</u>
<u>Security Council to the Secretary-General</u>

I have the honour to request you to transmit to the resumed forty-seventh session of the General Assembly the following resolution (resolution 828 (1993)) on the admission of Eritrea to membership in the United Nations, adopted by the Security Council at its 3218th meeting, on 26 May 1993:

"The Security Council,

"Having examined the application of Eritrea for admission to the United Nations, $\underline{1}/$

"Recommends to the General Assembly that Eritrea be admitted to membership in the United Nations.

"<u>1</u>/ A/47/948-s/25793."

I would point out that, when adopting the aforementioned resolution, the Security Council decided to have recourse to the provisions of the last paragraph of rule 60 of its provisional rules of procedure in order to submit its recommendation to the General Assembly at its resumed forty-seventh session.

In accordance with rule 60, paragraph 2, of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, I also request you to transmit to the General
