ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS TO THE UNITED NATIONS

Letter dated 26 May 1993 from the President of the  
Security Council to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to request you to transmit to the resumed forty-seventh session of the General Assembly the following resolution (resolution 829 (1993)) on the admission of the Principality of Monaco to membership in the United Nations, adopted by the Security Council at its 3219th meeting, on 26 May 1993:

"The Security Council,

"Having examined the application of the Principality of Monaco for admission to the United Nations, 1/

"Recommends to the General Assembly that the Principality of Monaco be admitted to membership in the United Nations.

I would point out that, when adopting the aforementioned resolution, the Security Council decided to have recourse to the provisions of the last paragraph of rule 60 of its provisional rules of procedure in order to submit its recommendation to the General Assembly at its resumed forty-seventh session.
