## FINANCIAL ASPECTS

- 1. By its resolution 49/231 of 23 December 1994, the General Assembly authorized me to enter into commitments for the United Nations Observer Mission in Georgia (UNOMIG) at a rate not to exceed \$1,720,034 gross (\$1,617,034 net) per month for the period from 14 January to 13 July 1995. This authorization is subject to the decision of the Security Council to extend the mandate of the Mission.
- 2. In my report to the Security Council of 6 January 1995 (S/1995/10), I recommended in paragraph 42 that the mandate of UNOMIG be extended for a further period until 15 May 1995.
- 3. Should the Security Council extend the mandate of UNOMIG beyond 13 January 1995, the monthly cost of maintaining the Mission will be limited to the commitment authority contained in General Assembly resolution 49/231.
- 4. As at 31 December 1994, unpaid assessed contributions to the Special Account for UNOMIG amounted to \$347,312. Total unpaid assessed contributions for all peace-keeping operations as at that date amounted to \$1.2 billion.
