GENERALIZED SYSTEM OF PREFERENCES

Scheme of Sweden

Amendment

The UNCTAD secretariat has received the following communication from the Permanent Mission of Sweden concerning that country's scheme of generalized preferences:

"This is to inform you that the following changes have been made in the Swedish GSP scheme:

"Uganda, owing to its status as a least developed country, is granted preferential treatment for all its products as from 1 April 1993.

"The following countries have been added to the list of beneficiaries to the Swedish GSP scheme as from the dates indicated:

- Croatia, as from 1 March 1992;
- Slovenia, as from 1 March 1992;
- Brunei Darussalam, as from 1 January 1993;
- The former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, as from 1 April 1993;
- Bosnia-Hercegovina, as from 1 April 1993.

"The following countries have been deleted from the list of beneficiaries owing to the fact that the EFTA countries have concluded free trade agreements with them:

- Turkey, as from 1 July 1993;
- Israel, as from 1 April 1993."
