The following information was received after 13 September 1994, the date of issuance of the original report of the Secretary-General (A/49/380), and should be included under section IV:

1. <u>Turkey</u> provided US\$ 51 million in humanitarian and emergency relief assistance to Azerbaijan in 1993 and between January and October 1994, of which \$5 million have been earmarked for the Autonomous Republic of Nakhichevan of the Azerbaijani Republic.

2. The breakdown of this amount is as follows:

(a) A total of 150,000 metric tons of wheat has been donated, the equivalent of 38 million;

(b) Two emergency relief camps for refugees and displaced persons have been set up by the Turkish Red Crescent in the Berde and Agcabedi regions of Azerbaijan, including health-care facilities. These camps are being run by the Turkish Red Crescent, and the total cost of this operation amounts to \$6 million. Currently, there are 12,000 refugees and displaced persons in these camps;

(c) A total of \$4.5 million in food, medicines, medical supplies, blankets and sanitation equipment has been donated;

(d) A total of \$2.5 million in fuel oil has been donated to the Autonomous Republic of Nakhichevan of the Azerbaijani Republic.
