LETTER DATED 8 JUNE 1993 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

In accordance with instructions from my Government, I have the honour to address Your Excellency with respect to the issue of monitors on the border between the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina and Serbia and Montenegro.

My Government strongly supports deployment of monitors along the border of Serbia and Montenegro as a matter of urgency. The monitors should be deployed all along the border and in such numbers and with such a mandate where they will have effective <u>control</u> of all traffic. Further, my Government would welcome deployment of monitors on Bosnia and Herzegovina side of the border.
