LETTER DATED 6 FEBRUARY 1995 FROM THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The members of the Security Council have noted your report of 4 February 1995 (S/1995/105) in response to paragraph 3 of Council resolution 968 (1994) of 16 December 1994.

The members of the Council endorse the recommendation contained in paragraph 32 of the report concerning the continuation of the presence of the United Nations Mission of Observers in Tajikistan (UNMOT) in Tajikistan for another month, until 6 March 1995. Continuation and effective observance of the cease-fire Agreement on 17 September 1994 (S/1994/1102, annex I) is vital. Reaffirming Security Council resolution 968 (1994), the members of the Council urge the parties in the interim to reconfirm through concrete steps their commitment to resolve the conflict only through political means, and their commitment to national reconciliation and to the promotion of democracy.
