In accordance with the provisions of Article 4 of the Charter of the United Nations, and with those of rule 58 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council and rule 134 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, I have the honour, in the name of the Principality of Andorra and in my capacity as Head of Government, to request the admission of the Principality of Andorra as a Member of the United Nations.

Accordingly, I hereby request you kindly to make this request known to the Security Council and to the General Assembly at their next respective meetings.

As stated in the official declaration attached hereto, the Principality of Andorra accepts and is willing to carry out the obligations set out in the Charter of the United Nations.
