ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS TO THE UNITED NATIONS

Letter dated 8 July 1993 from the President of the Security Council to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to request you to transmit to the General Assembly at its resumed forty-seventh session the following resolution (resolution 848 (1993)) on the admission of the Principality of Andorra to membership in the United Nations, adopted by the Security Council at its 3251st meeting, on 8 July 1993:

"The Security Council,

"Having examined the application of the Principality of Andorra for admission to the United Nations, 1/

"Recommends to the General Assembly that the Principality of Andorra be admitted to membership in the United Nations."

I would point out that, when adopting the resolution, the Security Council decided to have recourse to the provisions of the last paragraph of rule 60 of its provisional rules of procedure in order to submit its recommendation to the General Assembly at its resumed forty-seventh session.

In accordance with rule 60, paragraph 2, of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, I also request you to transmit to the General Assembly at its forty-seventh session, for its information, the verbatim records of the 3250th and 3251st meetings of the Council, at which the application of the Principality of Andorra was considered.
