REPORT OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON THE SITUATION IN ABKHAZIA, REPUBLIC OF GEORGIA

Addendum

1. The present addendum is a follow-up to my report to the Security Council of 1 July 1993 (S/26023), in which I indicated (para. 20) that I would shortly submit to the Council the preliminary cost estimates for the deployment of United Nations personnel to Georgia as described in paragraphs 17 and 18 of the report.
2. Should the Security Council decide to authorize the deployment of a United Nations military observer group in Georgia, it is estimated that the total cost would amount to \$9,005,000 gross for an initial six-month period. A breakdown of the estimated cost by main categories of expenditure is provided for information purposes in the annex to the present addendum.
3. It would be my recommendation to the General Assembly, should the Security Council decide to establish a United Nations military observer mission in Georgia, that the costs relating thereto should be considered an expense of the Organization to be borne by Member States in accordance with Article 17, paragraph 2, of the Charter of the United Nations and that the assessments to be levied on Member States should be credited to a special account to be established for this purpose.
