LETTER DATED 15 JULY 1993 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I. OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF FRANCE TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour to confirm, in accordance with Security Council resolution 841 (1993), paragraph 13, the following with respect to the implementation by France of the resolution.

The twelve member States of the European Community have drafted a text (EEC Regulation No. 18081 of 24 June 1993), published in the <u>Official Journal of the European Communities</u> of 26 June, incorporating the relevant provisions of resolution 841 (1993).

No further financial measure has so far been taken, since the Security Council's objectives and the mandatory provisions of resolution 841 (1993) are covered by Decree No. 91-1079 of 18 October 1991, by which prior authorization is required in respect of any financial payment abroad on behalf of bodies corporate or individuals under the direct or indirect authority of the Haitian State.

A notice to exporters, specifying the exemptions from the oil embargo imposed against the Haitian State, is in the course of issuance.

The regulation of 26 June 1993 and the text of the decree of 18 October 1991 are annexed hereto.\*
