NOTE VERBALE DATED 16 JULY 1993 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, pursuant to paragraph 13 of Security Council resolution 841 (1993), has the honour to inform him that European Community Regulation No. 1608/93 of 24 June 1993 implements in respect of the United Kingdom the ban on the sale or supply of petroleum and petroleum products to Haiti. The arms embargo has been implemented by an amendment to the Export of Goods (Control) Order (SI No. 1677 of 25 June 1993).

Further legislation implementing Security Council resolution 841 (1993) in the United Kingdom and the Dependent Territories will be contained in Orders in Council, which will become effective on 22 July 1993. Copies of the United Kingdom legislation will be forwarded shortly.*
