Letter dated 29 November 1994 from the Permanent
Representative of Peru to the United Nations
addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to inform you that on 9 December 1994 a ceremony organized by the Instituto Indigenista Peruano will be held in my country, in keeping with General Assembly resolution 48/163, of 21 December 1993, and at that event the Minister of Agriculture will officially inaugurate the International Decade of the World's Indigenous People in Peru.

This event provides further proof of the importance attached by the people and Government of Peru to the active participation of indigenous people and rural communities in the harmonious development of the nation and of Peru's clear commitment to the objectives of the International Decade of the World's Indigenous People.
