NOTE VERBALE DATED 15 JULY 1993 FROM THE PERMANENT
MISSION OF FINLAND TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED
TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of Finland to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General and, referring to paragraph 13 of Security Council resolution 841 (1993) of 16 June 1993, has the honour to provide him with the following information:

Security Council resolution 841 (1993) concerning Haiti has been implemented in Finland by a Decree* on the Enforcement of Obligations arising from the United Nations Security Council resolution on Haiti that entered into force on 15 July 1993.

As regards prevention of the sale and supply of petroleum, petroleum products, arms and related matériel to Haiti, paragraphs 5, 6 and 7 of resolution 841 (1993) have been implemented by paragraph 2 of the Decree.

Paragraph 8 of resolution 841 (1993), concerning the freezing of funds, has been implemented by paragraph 3 of the Decree. Paragraph 9, concerning agreements or contracts entered into or licences or permits granted before 23 June 1993, is implemented by paragraph 4 of the Decree.

As regards paragraph 12 of the resolution, it has been implemented by paragraph 6 of the Decree. In accordance with paragraph 4 of Act No. 659/67, concerning the Implementation of Certain Obligations Incumbent upon Finland as a Member of the United Nations, violation of the Decree implementing resolution 841 (1993) is a criminal offence and subject to imprisonment and fines, and seizure, confiscation, etc., of the proceeds of illegal acts.
