NOTE VERBALE DATED 27 JULY 1993 FROM THE PERMANENT  
REPRESENTATIVE OF ITALY TO THE UNITED NATIONS  
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of Italy to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, pursuant to paragraph 13 of Security Council resolution 841 (1993), has the honour to provide him with the following information:

1. The embargo on the sale or supply of petroleum and petroleum products to Haiti became automatically enforceable in Italy through the adoption on 24 June 1993 of regulation No. 93/1608 of the Council of the European Communities.
2. As regards weapons, ammunitions and related matériel, no further measures have been taken, since the provisions of Security Council resolution 841 (1993) are already covered by Italian Law No. 185/90 which bans the export of weapons to countries under United Nations embargo or which are held responsible for ascertained violations of human rights.
3. The freezing of the funds owned or controlled by those indicated in Security Council resolution 841 (1993) has been implemented by Decree No. 240 of the Government of Italy, which entered into force on 19 July 1993. The decree also establishes the administrative penalties for violating the prohibitions set forth in the decree itself and in regulation No. 93/1608 of the Council of the European Communities. A copy of the Italian legislation concerned will be forwarded shortly.
