### NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

1. On 16 June 1993, the Security Council adopted resolution 841 (1993) in connection with its consideration of the question concerning Haiti in response to the letter dated 7 June 1993 (S/25958) from the Permanent Representative of Haiti to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council.
2. In resolution 841 (1993) the Council decided that, acting under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations, starting on 23 June 1993, all States should adopt the measures set forth in paragraphs 5 to 14 of the resolution "unless the Secretary-General, having regard to the views of the Secretary-General of the Organization of American States, has reported to the Council that, in light of the results of the negotiations conducted by the Special Envoy for Haiti of the United Nations and Organization of American States Secretaries-General, the imposition of such measures is not warranted at that time".
3. The text of resolution 841 (1993) was transmitted to the Ministers for Foreign Affairs of all States upon its adoption. The text of the resolution was also transmitted to the Secretary-General of the Organization of American States.
4. Under the provisions of paragraph 13 of the same resolution, the Security Council requested all States to report to the Secretary-General by 16 July 1993 on the measures they had initiated for meeting the obligations set out in paragraphs 5 to 9 of the resolution.
5. As of 26 July 1993, 16 replies had been received pursuant to paragraph 13 of resolution 841 (1993). Each of the replies has been issued as a document of the Security Council in chronological order of their receipt, as indicated below:
