LETTER DATED 20 JULY 1993 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL  
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 831 (1993) of 27 May 1993, by which the Council decided to deploy a limited number of military observers as part of the United Nations Peace-keeping Force in Cyprus (UNFICYP).

Having completed consultations with potential contributors, I propose that the group of 12 military observers, to be deployed in the first week of August 1993, be composed of elements from the following States: Austria, Ireland and Hungary.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
