LETTER DATED 26 JULY 1993 FROM THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The members of the Council have considered your report (S/26090) of 16 July 1993 in response to paragraph 7 of the Council's resolution 840 (1993) of 15 June 1993 setting out your plans for the withdrawal of the United Nations Transitional Authority in Cambodia (UNTAC) and outlining some ideas for the possible role the United Nations and its agencies might play in Cambodia, with the agreement of the Cambodian Government, after the end of the mandate of UNTAC according to the Paris Agreements.

The members of the Council endorse the overall concept and arrangements contained in paragraphs 9-33 of your report concerning the withdrawal of UNTAC. They will continue their consideration of the remainder of the report.
