Statement dated 30 January 1995 by the Ministry for Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Tajikistan

The Ministry for Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Tajikistan presents its compliments to the United Nations and has the honour to announce that, in accordance with a decision of the Supreme Council, elections to the Majlis-i Oli (Parliament) of the Republic will take place on 26 February 1995.

The Ministry for Foreign Affairs, on behalf of the Central Commission on Elections and Referendums of the Republic of Tajikistan, requests the participation of observers in the electoral process.

In case of acceptance, we request that the observers' names be sent to Mr. Mizrob Saidovich Kabirov, Central Commission on Elections and Referendums (Prospekt Rudaki 42, Dushanbe, telephone No.: 21-13-42, 21-17-54) and to Mr. Khomid Saidovich Saidov, Ministry for Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Tajikistan (telephone No.: 21-43-77, 21-15-46, fax No.: (3772) 23-29-64).

The equipment, subsistence, travel and living costs for the observers in the Republic of Tajikistan shall be defrayed by the sending organization.

The Ministry for Foreign Affairs would be grateful if the United Nations could bring this information to the attention of Member States.

The Ministry takes this opportunity to convey to the United Nations the renewed assurances of its highest consideration.
