## List of issues

## (Submitted by the delegation of Cuba)

- 1. Identification of straddling species and highly migratory species the fishing of which requires consideration by the Conference.
- 2. Identification of the principal ocean areas where such species are found.
- 3. General obligations of States under the provisions of the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea and other related instruments.
- 4. Collection of scientific, technological and statistical data on fisheries resources, ecological factors, fishing fleets, fishing methods and other related issues.
- 5. Measures concerning conservation and rational management of fisheries resources (total allowable catch, quotas, seasons open and closed to fishing, fishing gear, etc.).
- 6. Registration of fishing vessels.
- 7. Reflagging of fishing vessels.
- 8. Monitoring and control mechanisms.
- 9. Assistance to developing countries.
- 10. Settlement of disputes.
- 11. Penalties.

- 12. Other matters (access to States which have not been engaged in high seas fishing).
- 13. Desirability of the elaboration and future adoption of legally binding rules or an international legal instrument on responsible fishing.
