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LETTER DATED 3 JUNE 1993 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I. OF  
THE PERMANENT MISSION OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN TO THE  
UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to bring to your attention the following instances of violations by Iraq of the terms of the cease-fire between the two countries.

1. On 26 March 1993, seven anti-revolutionaries with the support of Iraq crossed the international border and no man's land and by blocking the roads began extorting money from the passing vehicles at the geographic coordinates of 06-23 approximately 13 kilometres south-west of Baneh.
2. On 6 April 1993, at 0948 hours, eight Iraqi forces were observed conducting training exercises at the geographic coordinates of 333-444 on the map of Kouh Tunnel in no man's land south of border pillar 26/6.
3. On 8 April 1993, at 1850 hours, eight white Iraqi vehicles were observed trafficking at the geographic coordinates of 333-444 on the map of Kouh Tunnel in no man's land south of border pillar 26/6.
4. On 8 April 1993, seven anti-revolutionaries crossed the border and no man's land and penetrated about 16 kilometres into the territory of the Islamic Republic of Iran and by blocking the roads began extorting money from the Iranian vehicles.
5. On 9 April 1993, at 2030 hours, a number of anti-revolutionaries crossed the border and no man's land and penetrated about 16 kilometres into the territory of the Islamic Republic of Iran and by blocking the roads began extorting money from the passing vehicles.
6. On 10 April 1993, at 2330 hours, an illuminating mortar shell was fired by Iraqi forces from no man's land at the geographic coordinates of 05-68 around Mohammad Ghassem sentry post.
7. On 11 April 1993, at 1430 hours, an Iraqi IFA vehicle carrying eight Iraqi soldiers was observed trafficking at the geographic coordinates of 641-231 on the map of Kani-Sheikh and at the geographic coordinates of 70-23 on the map of Halaleh in no man's land, south-west of border pillar 39/1.

8. On 13 April 1993, at 1210 hours, five Iraqi forces were observed installing barbed wire at the geographic coordinates of 434-456 on the map of Naft-Shahr in no man's land, west of the Kand Kaboud border river.
9. On 13 April 1993, at 1300 hours, Iraqi forces were observed being disembarked from an Iraqi IFA vehicle at the geographic coordinates of 428-048 on the map of Khosravi, south of border pillar 53/2 in no man's land.
10. On 13 April 1993, at 2030 hours, four Iraqi forces entering no man's land intended to penetrate into the territory of the Islamic Republic of Iran at the geographic coordinates of 00-95 on the map of the Meimeh river south-west of border pillar 24/4. They ran away when confronted with the reaction of Iranian forces.
11. On 13 April 1993, at 2115 hours, four Iraqi forces crossed no man's land and the border and penetrated 60 kilometres into the territory of the Islamic Republic of Iran at the geographic coordinates of 0200 on the map of Kouh Gotbeh and the Meimeh river north of border pillar 24/2. They ran away when confronted with the reaction of Iranian forces.
12. On 14 April 1993, at 0110-0315 hours, a number of Iraqi agents crossed no man's land and penetrated into the territory of the Islamic Republic of Iran at the geographic coordinates of 300-820 on the map of Nahr-Anbar east of border pillar 22/31 and north-west of border pillar 22/30. They fled the area when confronted with the reaction of Iranian forces.
13. On 14 April 1993, at 1025-1300 hours, 10 Iraqi forces were observed conducting a reconnaissance operation at the geographic coordinates of 5068-10870 on the map of Mehran. Then, they moved towards Iraq's Mohammad Ghassem sentry post in no man's land.
14. On 15 April 1993, at 0330 hours, four Iraqi forces crossed no man's land and the international border at the geographic coordinates of 9540-0200 on the map of Kouh Gotbeh and penetrated into the territory of the Islamic Republic of Iran near the Ein-Mansour border sentry post. They fled the area when confronted with the reaction of Iranian forces.
15. On 15 April 1993, at 1545 hours, a number of anti-revolutionaries crossed no man's land and the international border at the geographic coordinates of 095-966 on the map of the Meimeh river and penetrated into the territory of the Islamic Republic of Iran north of border pillar 22/48. They fled into Iraq when confronted with the reaction of Iranian forces.
16. On 15 April 1993, at 1700 hours, four Iraqi forces were observed constructing a bunker at the geographic coordinates of 467-545 on the map of Naft-Shahr and Sumar south of border pillar 24/8.
17. On 29 April 1993, at 1350 hours, two Iraqi planes penetrated three to four miles into the Iranian airspace west of Dezful. Before any reaction from the Iranian forces, they fled back into Iraq.

It would be highly appreciated if this letter were circulated as a document of the Security Council.
