LETTER DATED 15 SEPTEMBER 1993 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to Article 94, paragraph 2, of the Charter of the United Nations, a request is hereby made that the Security Council take the necessary measures under Chapter 7 of the Charter in order to enforce the order of 13 September 1993 of the International Court of Justice pursuant to the "further Requests for the Indication of Provisional Measures" in the case concerning Application of the Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of the Crime of Genocide brought by the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina against "Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegro)".

The 13 September 1993 ruling reaffirms the Court's previous Order of 8 April 1993 and which should be "immediately and effectively implemented". In view of the fact that: (1) the aggression directed at the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina continues; (2) the genocide against the Bosnian people is unchecked, in contravention to the 8 April 1993, order; and (3) the genocide and aggression is furthered through the sieges of Bosnian cities including Sarajevo, Gorazde, other so-called "safe areas" and other areas, we call upon the Security Council to take the necessary and immediate steps to lift the sieges and thereby confront the ongoing genocide.

May I ask for your kind assistance in circulating this letter as a document of the Security Council.
