ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA OF THE FORTY-SEVENTH REGULAR SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND ALLOCATION OF ITEMS

Request for the inclusion of an additional sub-item submitted by the Secretary-General (A/47/907)

- 1. The CHAIRMAN invited the Committee to consider the request by the Secretary-General for the inclusion of a sub-item entitled "Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members and alternate members of the United Nations Staff Pension Committee" (A/47/907) in agenda item 17 of the forty-seventh regular session of the General Assembly.
- 2. The Committee decided to recommend that the General Assembly should include the additional sub-item in agenda item 17.
- 3. The Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the sub-item should be allocated to the Fifth Committee.

Request for the inclusion of an additional item submitted by Barbados (A/47/917)

- 4. The CHAIRMAN invited the Committee to consider the request by Barbados for the inclusion of an additional item entitled "Emergency assistance to Cuba" (A/47/917) in the agenda of the forty-seventh session.
- 5. Mr. ROGERS (Belize), speaking in his capacity as Chairman of the Group of Latin American and Caribbean States, said that, in view of the loss of life and damage to property caused by the violent storm that hit the western and central provinces of Cuba, the Group was requesting the inclusion of an additional item entitled "Emergency assistance to Cuba" in the agenda of the forty-seventh session of the General Assembly.
- 6. The Committee decided to recommend that the General Assembly should include the additional item in the agenda.
