- Note 1: All proposals should be received by the secretariat at the latest by 8 September 1993; the secretariat cannot guarantee that proposals received after that date will be translated or even circulated prior to the session.

- Note 3: Proposals for reclassification should be limited to a minimum; all proposals under agenda item 9 (Listing and classification) should be well argued and accompanied by full data sheets.
- Note 4: The terms of reference of a working group on the rationalization of the Manual of Tests and Criteria (agenda item 3) will be finalized on Monday, 22 November in the morning. The working group will be convened from Tuesday, 23 November p.m. to Thursday, 25 November a.m., to discuss Part I of the Manual and related matters. During that time, item 6 and subsequent items should be discussed in plenary. The report of the working group should be discussed on Thursday, 25 November a.m. (See also document ST/SG/AC.10/19, annex 2).
