## THE SITUATION OF DEMOCRACY AND HUMAN RIGHTS IN HAITI

Letter dated 10 September 1993 from the Permanent Representative of Mexico to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to inform you that, in the light of the adoption by the Security Council of resolution 861 (1993), the Government of Mexico has suspended sanctions against Haiti and decided to restore its diplomatic representation in that country to the highest level. The Government of Mexico will resume cooperation programmes and explore measures with the Haitian authorities for the purpose of promoting collaboration in accordance with the priorities established by Haiti's constitutional Government.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a document of the General Assembly, under item 22 of the agenda for its forty-seventh session, and of the Security Council.
