LETTER DATED 14 MARCH 1995 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 976 (1995) of 8 February concerning the establishment of the United Nations Angola Verification Mission (UNAVEM III).

As members of the Security Council are aware, the military component of UNAVEM III is currently composed of personnel from Algeria, Argentina, Bangladesh, Brazil, Bulgaria, Congo, Egypt, Guinea-Bissau, Hungary, India, Jordan, Kenya, Malaysia, Mali, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Nigeria, Norway, Pakistan, Poland, Portugal, the Russian Federation, Senegal, Slovakia, Sweden, Uruguay, Zambia and Zimbabwe.

Following the usual consultations, I propose that France, Romania, and the United Kingdom be added to the list of countries contributing military personnel to UNAVEM.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
