REPORT OF THE AD HOC COMMITTEE TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AT ITS FORTY-NINTH SESSION (A/AC.159/L.121)

1. The CHAIRMAN invited the Rapporteur to introduce parts I and II of the Committee's draft report, published as document A/AC.159/L.121, while the Committee finished preparing the text of conclusions and recommendations which would figure in part III and considering the various proposals made as to new alternative approaches. The Committee might also think it appropriate to include a resolution for the General Assembly in its report.
2. Mr. RAKOTONDRAMBOA (Madagascar), Rapporteur, introduced the Committee's draft report, issued as document A/AC.159/L.121. In paragraph 4, the figure 14 should be replaced by 16, and Kenya and Zambia should be added to the list of countries which had made statements in the general discussion. Part III would be added when the Committee had adopted its conclusions and recommendations, and would if necessary be accompanied by an annex.
3. The CHAIRMAN said that if there were no objections, he would take it that the Committee wished to adopt the Committee's draft report issued as document A/AC.159/L.121, as orally revised by the Rapporteur, with the exception of paragraphs 9 and 10, which it would adopt at its 437th meeting, when it completed its work.
4. It was so decided.
