Note by the Secretary-General

1. In paragraph 25 of its resolution 47/191 of 22 December 1992, the General Assembly requested the Governing Council of the United Nations Environment Programme, the Governing Council of the United Nations Development Programme and the Trade and Development Board to examine the relevant provisions of chapter 38 of Agenda 21 1/ at their next sessions and to submit to the General Assembly at its forty-eighth session, through the Commission on Sustainable Development and the Economic and Social Council, reports on their specific plans to implement Agenda 21.

2. Annexed to the present note is a report of the Governing Council of UNEP on plans to implement Agenda 21, which was considered by the Governing Council at its seventeenth session, held at Nairobi from 10 to 21 May.
