### ORGANIZATION OF WORK OF THE SECOND COMMITTEE

#### Note by the Secretariat

#### Allocation of items

1. The agenda items allocated by the General Assembly to the Second Committee are listed in the letter dated 24 September 1993 from the President of the Assembly to the Chairman of the Second Committee (A/C.2/48/1). Background information on those items may be found in the annotations to the agenda (A/48/100).

#### Programme of work

2. The draft programme of work (see annex) has been prepared bearing in mind paragraph (b) of rule 99 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, the organizational arrangements agreed upon by the Assembly at the outset of its current session (A/48/250 and Add.1), and the availability of documentation. The number of meetings suggested for the general discussion of the agenda items allocated to the Second Committee is based on past experience and takes into account the measures announced by the Secretary-General in his address to the 71st meeting of the Fifth Committee (see document A/C.5/47/SR.71), on 26 August 1993, regarding the current financial situation of the United Nations and the need to introduce certain measures affecting conference services.

#### List of documents

3. Attention is drawn to the list of documents submitted under the various agenda items allocated to the Second Committee, which will be issued in an addendum to the present document (A/C.2/48/L.1/Add.1). The draft programme of work should be read in conjunction with the list of documents in order to obtain a full picture of the scope of the Committee's work programme.

Length of statements

4. In recent years, the Second Committee decided to limit statements on all agenda items, with the exception of the general debate, to 10 minutes and to limit statements during the general debate to 15 minutes. In view of the reduced number of meetings available to the Committee during the session, it is suggested that the time-limit on general debate statements be set at 10 minutes and statements on agenda items at 5 minutes.

Conference facilities and meetings arrangements

5. Taking into account the availability of conference services for the Main Committees of the General Assembly, an average of six formal meetings a week have been scheduled for the Second Committee. Unless otherwise specified, meetings will be held at 10 a.m. and 3 p.m. In this connection, the General Assembly decided to remind delegations that punctuality is of the utmost importance in the interest of ensuring an effective and orderly organization of work and achieving economies for the United Nations. As decided by the General Assembly, the requirement of the presence of at least one quarter of the members of the Committee to declare a meeting open and permit the debate to proceed has been waived.

Informal consultations

6. In view of the financial measures affecting conference services mentioned in paragraph 2 above, there will be little possibility of servicing informal consultations or working groups, or meetings of regional or other groups of Member States. As a result, as indicated in the programme of work, some of the formal meetings allocated to the Second Committee will be utilized for informal consultations.

Report of the Economic and Social Council

7. The Committee is reminded that, in accordance with a decision of the General Assembly, chapters of the report of the Economic and Social Council are to be considered in company with other agenda items, as well as under item 12. The list of documentation contains further information on this procedure (see para. 3 above).

Conclusion of the work of the Committee

8. Bearing in mind the allocation of the number of meetings available to the Second Committee, it is proposed that the Second Committee set a target date of 10 December for the conclusion of its work. In view of the decreased availability of services, it is highly unlikely that services can be counted on after this date.
