LETTER DATED 4 OCTOBER 1993 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to refer to paragraph 1 of resolution 867 (1993) of 23 September 1993, by which the Security Council decided to establish the United Nations Mission in Haiti (UNMIH).

Following the usual consultations, I intend, if the Council so agrees, to appoint Colonel Gregg Pulley of the United States of America as Commander of the United Nations military unit of UNMIH.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the Security Council.
