Referring to decision 5.4.3 of 28 May 1993 adopted by the Executive Board of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization at its 141st session,

Bearing in mind its resolution 1980/67 of 25 July 1980 and General Assembly decision 35/424 of 5 December 1980, concerning guidelines for international years and anniversaries,

- 1. <u>Stresses</u> the importance of national and international efforts to promote tolerance;
- 2. Takes note with appreciation of the report of the Director-General of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization containing his suggestions on the observance of the United Nations year for tolerance; $\underline{1}/$
- 3. $\underline{\text{Encourages}}$ the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization to continue its work on the preparation of a declaration on tolerance;
- 4. Recommends that the General Assembly at its forty-eight session, proclaim 1995 as the United Nations year for tolerance.
