Statement on Haiti issued by the European Community and its member States on 15 October 1993

The European Community and its member States express their indignation following the murder of the Minister for Justice of the constitutional Government of Haiti, Mr. Malary. They call for those responsible to be pursued and punished. The European Community and its member States condemn attempts to sabotage the Governors Island agreement of 3 July, which is to lead to the restoration of constitutional order and the return of President Aristide on 30 October. They reiterate their full support for the Government of Prime Minister Malval.
