REPORT OF THE INTERNATIONAL CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION

PROGRAMME BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM 1980-1981

Administrative and financial implications of the draft resolution contained in document A/C.5/35/L.31

Statement submitted by the Secretary-General in accordance with rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly

- 1. Under the terms of paragraph 18 of the draft resolution contained in document A/C.5/35/L.31, the General Assembly would decide to establish, effective 1 January 1981, three temporary posts (one P-3, one G-5 and one G-4) in the Cost-of-Living Section of the Commission's secretariat as requested by the Commission pending the study of long-term needs of the secretariat to be submitted to the General Assembly at its thirty-sixth session.
- 2. The establishment of the three temporary posts (one P-3, one G-5 and one G-4) would give rise to administrative and financial implications, as follows:

- 3. Should the General Assembly therefore approve the establishment of the three posts requested under operative paragraph 18 of the draft resolution contained in document A/C.5/35/L.31, additional appropriation in the amount of \$100,000 under section 28 L would be required for the biennium 1980-1981. A further provision of \$18,400 would be required for staff assessment under section 31 which would be offset by an equivalent amount under income section 1.
- 4. Estimates of income under income section 2 would need to be increased by \$63,000 representing 63 per cent of the appropriation requested under section 28 L in respect of reimbursement by the specialized agencies of their share of the costs of the International Civil Service Commission.
