LETTER DATED 25 OCTOBER 1993 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF BURUNDI TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Further to my letter No. 204.10.15/327/RE/NY/93 of 22 October 1993, I have the honour to request you to convene, as a matter of urgency, a meeting of the Security Council on the tragic situation now prevailing in my country.

According to the information we have received, massacres of all kinds are taking place and if nothing is done to stop them, the country runs the risk of becoming engulfed in a civil war with incalculable consequences for international peace and security.

I should therefore be grateful if you would use your authority so that the Security Council may meet to take urgent and energetic measures with a view to restoring peace and ensuring a return to the normal constitutional order.
