LETTER DATED 8 OCTOBER 1993 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 867 of 23 September 1993 (S/26536) by which the Council decided to establish a United Nations Mission in Haiti (UNMIH) and to your letter of 6 October 1993 confirming the composition of the military and police components of UNMIH.

Having completed consultations, I propose that Spain also contribute to the police component of UNMIH.

Spain has expressed its readiness in principle to make the necessary personnel available.

I am awaiting replies from certain other States which have been informally approached and will revert to the Security Council when I have an indication of whether they are also ready in principle to contribute personnel to this mission.

I should be grateful to you if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
