Announcement dated 17 March 1995 by the Central Commission
on Elections and Referendums of the Republic of Tajikistan
on the results of the elections to the Majlis-i Oli

Having considered the reports submitted by the area electoral commissions on the results of the elections of peoples' deputies of the Republic of Tajikistan, the Central Commission on Elections and Referendums announces that 2,650,267 people were included in the electoral rolls and that 2,419,722 voters, or 91.07 per cent, participated in the voting.

For the election of peoples' deputies of the Republic of Tajikistan, 181 electoral districts were formed, in which there were 350 candidates on the ballot.

Elections were held in all the electoral districts. On 26 February 1995, peoples' deputies to the Majlis-i Oli of the Republic of Tajikistan were elected in 163 electoral districts. In 17 electoral districts, in each of which there were more than two candidates, none was elected and on 12 March 1995 a further election was held.

In one electoral district, where there were two candidates and neither was elected, a further election will be held in accordance with article 48 of the Law of the Republic of Tajikistan "On elections to the Majlis-i Oli of the Republic of Tajikistan".

On the basis of article 44 of the Electoral Law, the Central Commission on Elections and Referendums registered all 180 peoples' deputies of the Republic of Tajikistan elected on 26 February 1995 and in the further election held on 12 March 1995.
