Adición

1. En su período de sesiones de organización celebrado del 12 al 16 de abril de 1993, el Comité Preparatorio de la Cumbre Mundial sobre Desarrollo Social adoptó la decisión 2, relativa a las modalidades de participación de las organizaciones no gubernamentales en la Cumbre y su proceso preparatorio y su contribución a éstos¹.
2. El propósito de la presente nota es ofrecer al Comité Preparatorio información pertinente sobre las organizaciones no gubernamentales que no están reconocidas como entidades consultivas por el Consejo Económico y Social o que no figuran en la Lista del Consejo y que han solicitado la acreditación en la Cumbre y en su proceso preparatorio.
3.
