Statement concerning the agreement of mutual recognition between Israel and the Palestine Liberation Organization issued on 11 September 1993 by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Singapore

The Government of Singapore applauds the exchange of letters between Israel and the Palestine Liberation Organization (PLO) on mutual recognition that took place on 9 September 1993.

This is a historic step towards reconciliation between the Israeli and Palestinian peoples. It will pave the way for the signing of the Declaration of Principles between Israel and the PLO. This landmark agreement will help to end the decades of conflict and bloodshed in the Middle East. The Government of Singapore hopes that all parties will work together to build on these first steps and restore peace and stability in the region.
