LETTER DATED 8 NOVEMBER 1993 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I.
OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF IRAQ TO THE UNITED NATIONS
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government and further to my letter of 10 September 1993 (S/26433), I have the honour to transmit to you herewith a table showing accidental detonations of bombs, missiles and other ordnance used by the aggressor States against my country (table 1) and a table showing 8,228 miscellaneous bombs, shells and missiles found and dealt with by the unexploded ordnance disposal teams of the civil defence departments of all governorates of Iraq (table 2). The period covered is 1 to 31 October 1993.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter and its annex circulated as a document of the Security Council.
