LETTER DATED 16 NOVEMBER 1993 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 880 (1993) of 3 November 1993 by which the Council decided to establish a United Nations Military Liaison Team in Cambodia, and to my report of 27 October 1993 relating to the designation of a Chief Military Liaison Officer (CMLO).

Having completed the necessary consultations, I propose to form the Military Liaison Team of 20 Military Liaison Officers from contributions offered by 15 nations. They are: Austria, Bangladesh, Belgium, China, France, India, Indonesia, Malaysia, New Zealand, Pakistan, Poland, Russia, Singapore, Thailand and Uruquay.

I further propose, with the consent of the Council, to appoint Col. A. N. M. Muniruzzaman (Bangladesh) as the Chief Military Liaison Officer.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
