COOPERATION BETWEEN THE UNITED NATIONS AND THE LATIN AMERICAN ECONOMIC SYSTEM

Argentina, Barbados, Belize, Bolivia, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, <u>Costa Rica, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, El Salvador,</u> <u>Grenada, Guatemala, Guyana, Haiti, Honduras, Jamaica, Mexico,</u> <u>Nicaragua, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Suriname, Trinidad and</u> <u>Tobago, Uruguay and Venezuela: draft resolution</u>

The General Assembly,

<u>Recalling</u> its resolution 47/13 of 29 October 1992 on cooperation between the United Nations and the Latin American Economic System,

<u>Having considered</u> the report of the Secretary-General on cooperation between the United Nations and the Latin American Economic System, $\underline{1}/$

<u>Bearing in mind</u> the Agreement between the United Nations and the Latin American Economic System, in which the parties agree to strengthen and expand their cooperation in matters which are of common concern in the field of their respective competence pursuant to their constitutional instruments,

<u>Considering</u> that the Economic Commission for Latin America and the Caribbean has developed ties of cooperation with the Latin American Economic System which have grown stronger in recent years,

<u>Bearing in mind</u> that the Permanent Secretariat of the Latin American Economic System has carried out several programmes with the support of the United Nations Development Programme in areas that are considered of priority for the economic development of the region,

<u>Considering also</u> that the Latin American Economic System is developing joint activities with the specialized agencies and other organizations and

programmes of the United Nations system, such as the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development, the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization, the United Nations Industrial Development Organization, the World Meteorological Organization, the World Health Organization, the World Intellectual Property Organization, the United Nations Environment Programme, the Department of Economic and Social Development, the Office of the United Nations Disaster Relief Coordinator, the United Nations Institute for Training and Research and the International Telecommunication Union,

<u>Welcoming</u> the recent decision of the Latin American Council expressing appreciation to the international organizations and other institutions providing support to the Permanent Secretariat of the Latin American Economic System,

1. <u>Takes note with satisfaction</u> of the report of the Secretary-General;

2. <u>Urges</u> the Economic Commission for Latin America and the Caribbean to continue broadening and deepening its coordination and mutual support activities with the Latin American Economic System;

3. <u>Urges</u> the United Nations Development Programme to strengthen and expand its support to the programmes that the Permanent Secretariat of the Latin American Economic System is carrying out, aimed at complementing the technical assistance activities conducted by the Latin American Economic System;

4. <u>Urges</u> the specialized agencies and other organizations and programmes of the United Nations system to continue and intensify their support for and cooperation with the activities of the Latin American Economic System;

5. <u>Requests</u> both the Secretary-General of the United Nations and the Permanent Secretary of the Latin American Economic System to assess, at the appropriate time, the implementation of the Agreement between the United Nations and the Latin American Economic System, and to report thereon to the General Assembly at its forty-ninth session;

6. <u>Requests</u> the Secretary-General to submit to the General Assembly at its forty-ninth session a report on the implementation of the present resolution.
