It is proposed that the following amendments and additions in the Draft Declaration and Draft Programme of Action (A/CONF.166/PC/L.22) be incorporated in a revised version of the document as follows:

DRAFT DECLARATION

(i) Commitment 8 might be reworded as follows:

'We commit ourselves to help generating, increase significantly and utilize more efficiently the resources available for social development.'

DRAFT PROGRAMME OF ACTION
