Letter dated 6 December 1993 from the Permanent Representative of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

I refer to the letter of 24 November 1993 addressed to you by the Permanent Representative of Bosnia and Herzegovina to the United Nations (A/48/659-S/26806), enclosing a "statement of intention by the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina to institute legal proceedings against the United Kingdom before the International Court of Justice".

The Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland rejects as totally without foundation the allegations contained in the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina's statement of intention to institute legal proceedings against the United Kingdom. If such proceedings are initiated, they will be vigorously defended.

I request that the present letter be circulated as a document of the General Assembly, under agenda item 42, and of the Security Council.
