SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE STAGE REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in document S/13737 of 11 January 1980, S/13737/Add.35 of 10 September 1980 and S/13737/Add.38 of 3 October 1980.

At its 2249th meeting, held in private on 14 October 1980, the Security Council considered its draft report to the General Assembly covering the period 16 June 1979 to 15 June 1980. The Security Council approved the report unanimously.

During the week ending 18 October 1980, the Security Council also took action on the following item:

The situation between Iran and Iraq

The Security Council continued its consideration of the item at its 2250th and 2251st meetings, held on 15 and 17 October 1980. In addition to the representatives invited previously, the President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Cuba and Iran, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.
