LETTER DATED 3 DECEMBER 1993 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 866 (1993) of 22 September 1993, by which the Council authorized the establishment of the United Nations Observer Mission in Liberia (UNOMIL).

In my letters of 4 October 1993 (S/26554) and 17 November 1993 (S/26778), I submitted to the Council the list of Member States contributing military personnel to UNOMIL. Having completed the necessary additional consultations, I propose that India be added to the list of contributing countries.

I am continuing to consult certain other States and will revert to the Security Council when I have an indication of whether they are also ready in principle to contribute military personnel to this mission.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
