## FINANCING OF THE UNITED NATIONS MISSION IN HAITI

## Report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions

- 1. The Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions has considered the Secretary-General's report on the financing of the United Nations Mission in Haiti (UNMIH) (A/C.5/48/40, paras. 92-104).
- 2. By its resolution 867 (1993) of 23 September 1993, the Security Council authorized the establishment of UNMIH for a period of six months subject to the proviso that it would be extended beyond 75 days only upon a review by the Council.
- 3. For reasons given in paragraphs 98 to 101 of the Secretary-General's report, it is estimated that the requirements of UNMIH for its maintenance since its inception on 23 September 1993 through 30 April 1994 would be \$1,383,000 gross (\$1,364,000 net). The Advisory Committee recommends that the General Assembly authorize the commitment and assessment of this amount.
