SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF
WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE STAGE
REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in documents S/1994/40 of 16 January 1995 and S/1995/40/Add.2 of 25 January 1995.

During the week ending 15 April 1995, the Security Council took action on the following items:

The proposal by China, France, the Russian Federation, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the United States of America on security assurances

By a letter dated 6 April 1995 addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/1995/271), the Permanent Representative of the Russian Federation to the United Nations, as coordinator and on behalf of the five permanent members of the Security Council, requested that an item entitled "The proposal by China, France, the Russian Federation, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the United States of America on security assurances" be inscribed on the agenda of the Security Council.

The Security Council met to consider the item at its 3514th meeting, held on 11 April 1995 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations. There was one suspension and one resumption of the meeting.

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Algeria, Egypt, Hungary, India, the Islamic Republic of Iran, Malaysia, Pakistan, Romania and Ukraine, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President drew attention to the text of a draft resolution (S/1995/275) submitted by China, France, the Russian Federation, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the United States of America.

Upon the resumption of the meeting following a suspension at noon, the Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/1995/275 and adopted it unanimously as resolution 984 (1995) (for the text, see S/RES/984 (1995); to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Fiftieth Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1995).

The President stated that, following consultations of the Council, he had been authorized to make a statement on behalf of the Council and read out the text of that statement (for the text, see S/PRST/1995/16; to be issued in Official Records of the Security Council, Fiftieth Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1995).
