SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE STAGE REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/1995/325 and adopted it unanimously as resolution 989 (1995) (for the full text, see S/RES/989 (1995) (reissued for technical reasons); to be issued in <u>Official</u> <u>Records of the Security Council, Fiftieth Year, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, (1995)</u>.
