1. At its 43rd meeting, on 18 December 1993, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/48/54) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution A/48/L.33. The related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/48/SR.43).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A/48/L.33, no additional appropriation would be required under the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1994-1995. The question of additional premises that might be required would need to be examined by the Secretary-General and the Executive Heads of the United Nations Development Programme, the United Nations Population Fund and the United Nations Children's Fund and the Secretary-General should report thereon to the General Assembly, through the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions.
